

Security Committee Security Patrol Proposal

As a result of the pandemic and related social issues, there has been an uptick of crime. Our neighborhood is no different. As a result, neighbors got together and put together a proposal for security patrols in East Montrose. The East Montrose boundaries are Fairview – Montrose – West Gray – Genesee.

Patrol Option Recommendation

SEAL Patrol (private security company)
40 hours/week (tentatively Wednesday – Sunday evenings from 10pm – 6am)
Cost = \$37/hour x 40 hours/week x 52 weeks = \$76,960
East Montrose Civic Association is a 501 c4 non-profit, meaning we don't have to pay sales tax.
Commencing January 1, 2022 or as soon as we get enough members to cover a contract period.

Note - Another option is the Harris County Constable patrol. It is a bit more costly and less flexible but worthy of discussion before the October 2022 application deadline.

Membership Costs

Membership would be $^{\sim}$ \$365/year if we can get 211 members (less if we can get more). This is only \$1/day (less than a cup of coffee).

Members receive a hotline number to call as well as a yard sign indicating your participation. We can also list members on the EMCA website.

Neighborhood artist, **Joan Son** is having a retrospective of her art at the Pearl Fincher Museum of Fine Art which opens Friday, December 17 and runs through Saturday, January 8, 2022. She hopes you will all come to her artist talk on Saturday the 18th at 3:00!

Joan is a child of the 1960's. Her fascination with paper began with folded fortune tellers, tissue paper carnations, and paper doll dresses. When her best girlfriend introduced her to origami she said it felt like magic! As a grown up, her graphic career evolved into design and production of catalogs for Foley's Department stores.

After 20 years of commercial art, she debuted her origami work in the windows of Tiffany & Co., Houston, Galleria, in the spring of 1993. Since 2017, she has been exploring her inspiration to paint images with an emphasis on clouds. In a deconstruction/reconstruction process, she cuts the painting into pieces, folds each one, then unfolds and reassembles the painting.

Joan continues to be crazy about paper and is guided by the directive from beloved artist, Agnes Martin, to have "obedience to inspiration."
