From the Security Committee ... by Hugo Ovalle

Are you, like me, the proud dog parent of a pandemic puppy who loves to take a walk before bedtime? Or someone who likes to stroll the neighborhood in late afternoon, enjoying the beautiful sunshine (before the August sun sets in!)? Do you mainly shop from places like Amazon, and eagerly await coming home to find packages on your porch? Then you, like me, must have noticed the increase in vandalism and crime in our neighborhood – the broken glass in the streets and the empty Amazon packages lying on the sidewalk. Many of us think that there is nothing we can do to combat this trend in our neighborhood, but a group of East Montrose neighbors would disagree. At this time, we have raised enough funds for 8-9 months of patrols. As more individuals sign up we will be able to extend the contract period. A few weeks ago, the EMCA security committee, which is made up of folks like you and me, hosted a get together so we could meet security officers from SEAL, which is the security company we have selected to patrol our neighborhood. Those of us who attended asked questions and were able to see for ourselves the quality of the company that will be providing security for us. The security committee is in the process of vetting the contract with SEAL, finalizing the details of their service to our community. After the contract has been approved and signed, we will have a firm start date.

The security committee will continue to meet regularly after SEAL begins patrolling the neighborhood. Members of the committee will review data submitted by SEAL, which will detail hours the security officer was in the neighborhood, the contacts the security officer has with people in the neighborhood, and any other pertinent information. EMCA will update our website to host statistics from the patrols as well as any comments from our neighbors.

It is not too late to join many of your neighbors who have come together to protect our wonderful neighborhood from vandalism and other crimes.
